Sanitiser - Concentrate



Suma San Conc D4a conc is a concentrated sanitiser for use on all hard surfaces including food contact surfaces in food premises. Suma San Conc D4a conc is also suitable for laundry sanitising.

Key Properties

Suma San Conc D4a conc is a concentrated liquid sanitiser. The optimal blend of Quaternary Ammonium Compound and wetting agents in Suma San Conc D4a conc makes it very effective as a sanitiser against a wide spectrum of micro-organisms, in all water conditions. The product can be used as a no-rinse sanitiser when diluted to an in-use concentration of <200ppm Quarternary Ammonium Compound.

For dosing accuracy Suma San Conc D4 conc should be dosed via the Diversey Refill dosing system.

Directions for Use

No Rinse Spray Sanitising

For soiled areas, always pre-clean with a Diversey detergent and rinse with water

- 1. Fill up the bottle with water. Insert the bottle in the Divermite dispenser and push once (3ml/750ml)
- 2. Spray surface and leave for 3 minutes
- 3. Wipe surface with clean paper towel and allow to air dry.
- 4. Direct contact with prescribed goods must be prevented and treated surfaces adequately drained before processing operations resume.

A made up spray bottle of product will be active for up to seven days. Rinse and dry bottle before refilling.

No Rinse General Sanitising

For soiled areas, always pre-clean with a Diversey detergent and rinse with water

- 1. Use at a concentration of 4 pushes (12ml) in 3L cool water
- 2. Apply solution with cloth or brush or soak
- 3. Leave for at least 3 minutes
- 3. Drain or wipe surface with clean paper towel and allow to air dry
- 4. Direct contact with prescribed goods must be prevented and treated surfaces adequately drained before processing operations resume

A rinse with potable water after application is required when the product is used by operators processing non-dairy animal products who are operating under the Animal Products Act (APA) regime. Fish processing plants are excluded from this requirement.

Laundry Sanitising

Dose Suma San Conc D4a conc into the final rinse cycle of the washing machine. Please consult your Diversey representative for further application advice.

Microbiological data

Suma San Conc D4a conc tested at a dilution of 3ml/750ml (200ppm) and in clean conditions, 3 minutes contact time gave the following reduction in organisms.

Escherichia Coli. >99.999%
Staphylococcus aureus >99.999%
Salmonella choleraesuis >99.999%
Listeria monocytogenes >99.999%
